Please send abstracts of up to **250 words** by **1**st **April** to the Human Reproduction Co-Convenor Kylie Baldwin. Abstracts significantly over the word count will not be accepted. Presentation slots will be 15 minutes long.

Abstracts will be anonymised when reviewed by the Co-Convenors of the group, taking into account the suitability of the topic, the stage of research process (if appropriate), and the significance of the findings or arguments proposed.
