Would you like to become more involved in running the Study Group? Lisa is stepping down as a co-convenor, so Alice and Kitty are looking for new colleagues to take over. This is open to all current BSA members across all career stages, including PhD students and early career academics.

The main tasks for Study Group Convenors include liaising with the BSA; managing the budget; maintaining the membership list; circulating relevant information around the group, including through Network, email and Twitter; organising occasional workshops and other events; and promoting the group more generally.

Running events usually involves circulating a call for papers to the membership via email and Twitter, putting together a programme, liaising with the BSA Events Team over budget and promotion, and making the practical arrangements.

The convenors also manage the membership list. This involves approving requests to join, and circulating information about publications, events, jobs etc., that might be of interest to members. We currently have a thriving membership of approx. 250. Convenors also attend BSA Convenors' Meetings on zoom, and write an Annual Report on the group's activities (our most recent Annual Report is attached here).
